Tonight in a persistent light snowstorm, more than 600 filled the front of the open-air tabernacle, committing their lives to Christ.

The pastors believe the crusade will forever change Soloma, Guatemala. Visible decisions during the crusade, number more than 1,500. The impact on the lives of the Christians who attended the crusade is hard to evaluate, except by what was seen on the hundreds of faces.

We are praying that the messages heard over radio have resulted in hundreds more coming to Christ Jesus. The signal from one of the 3 radio stations that transmitted the last two crusade meetings, reached a large area of Southern Mexico and the community of Barillas, Guatemala where Rigo will preach next week's crusade.

Rigo saw God honored in the lives of 20 pastors and their churches who because of their love for the Lord gladly paid a dear price to hold this crusade.

I love Rigo like a son, and I have seen that this crusade has transformed his life and he will never be the same.

When I cautioned him to be careful lest he fall into the sin of pride because of so many accepting Christ, he said "being around these pastors is totally humbling, for they are men of God who truly love Him and willingly pay a price to serve Him".

Every night Rigo has slept in an inexpensive unheated hotel room in freezing weather. There is hot water for a certain period of time each morning. His meals have been limited. In the time in Soloma, Rigo has again recognized

that it is his love for the Lord that has compelled him to leave his family, travel over dangerous mountain roads, live under austere conditions, and tax his strength and health. He is worthy of your interceding before the throne of God in his behalf.

Money arrived today in Texas so Monday we can send Rigo a very much-needed Moneygram. Thank the Lord for the arrival of this gift.
