Recently, every trip I make seems to be the most important one so far. There are many important factors in tomorrow's trip to Guatemala!

This trip will have its physically exhausting times, not because we're driving up mountainous roads blocked by landslides, but because the length of trips both down and back to the Atlantic Coastal Area of Guatemala are long.

Praise the Lord, this morning at 2:30; I completed writing the 30 Page Booklet, specifically written about Revival coming to Guatemala this year. Dale Jones, my dear brother and college roommate, has edited the English.

Another great blessing, is that a very dear Guatemalan missionary friend, David Ekstrom, is translating this booklet into Spanish. He and his lovely wife, Helen, both were MKs (missionary kids) and have been in Guatemala as missionaries for more than 50 years. During this time, they have translated the New Testament into five Mayan languages! Both are in their 80s, and Helen has just gone through major cancer surgery. So you see how blessed we are that the perfect person for this task volunteered without my asking, Thank you Lord!

Hopefully, during this trip we can contract with a Guatemalan printer to have at least 50,000 copies of the booklet printed, to be distributed to

as many churches as possible, of every denomination, throughout the country. At this point we cannot print even 1000 copies.

As I write this letter, Rigo is in Huehuetenango, making arrangements for our large crusade in that city to be held in December. He and I will meet in Guatemala City this coming Monday.

Tuesday morning early, along with a Guatemalan brother in the Lord, Diego Cruz, we will drive four hours to where I am also to speak for four hours to a large group of pastors and leaders.

Then, the next day, we will go to Puerto Barrios, Guatemala's Gulf Port City, to repeat what happened the day before. While in Puerto Barrios, I will do a one-hour radio interview about revival in Guatemala, on a station that reaches half of the country, and then that night to again preach in a local church.

After a long road trip back to Guatemala City we will have a meeting with the Guatemalan Ministerial Alliance Board Members, to talk to them about Revival in their country.

We will be meeting with leaders of many of the larger denominations in that country with the same message. God has opened the door for me to do a one-hour interview on the most respected Christian radio program that reaches the entire country.

PLEASE PRAY FOR GOD TO GREATLY USE THIS TRIP.

Rigo will return home to San Jose and 9 days later, he will leave for a two-week trip to Northern Colombia to train pastors and members of churches in two cities. This is our pre-crusade phase for the 2 Crusades in January.

A large number of pastors gathered for a conference call with Rigo, and he was greatly blessed by their overwhelming enthusiasm for his coming to hold a crusade like they have never had before.

PLEASE PRAY FOR RIGO AND HIS TRIPS AND EACH OF THE FORTHCOMING CRUSADES.

Only by God's grace and a strong burden from Him am I willing to leave my Judy and start off on a trip that will, to say the least, exacerbate my pain levels. Please do not misunderstand me, I'm not complaining, but rather I'm grateful that my Great and Loving God can still use this beat up body and feeble mind for His glory.

Do you want to know something that is beyond understanding and therefore is of God? The only time I am without pain is when I am preaching.

A very personal story of God's grace: I was literally helped up on a stage by two men, where I preached without stopping and without pain for 4 hours and 15 minutes to 2400 pastors and leaders (no one got up and left, and no one went to sleep). At the conclusion I was almost

literally carried down the stairs by three men. But oh! How God honestly blessed that message to impact the lives of many, including myself!

This morning, I received a call from a Pastor in a small, rural community of Guatemala. He and I had spoken for some time at the Convention last month.

His phone call was filled with emotion, as he poured out his heart about his time with the Lord in the middle of last night. He asked me, in tears, to pray for him while on the phone, that he might know personal revival and the presence of the Lord in his life. Great revivals often begin in the despair of one man, to know God's presence in his life.

PLEASE PRAY FOR MARCELO, THAT HE MIGHT BE THAT MAN.

Only through your daily prayers and financial support are Rigo and I able to do what God has called us to do. Your prayers keep us hidden behind the cross and your support allows us to make these important trips.

Like the apostle Paul, I can also say, "I thank my God for every memory of you all."
